Biography of missionary Diacui Monteiro Braga Of the "Way of Life Assembly of God" Church ADCV (Brasil)

The Missionary Diacui Monteiro Braga was born in the city of Sobradinho, Brasilia, Federal District, Brazil, on February 26, 1961, daughter of Raimundo Monteiro Braga and Natalia Carlos Monteiro. She is the third of seven brothers. At the age of 16, she almost completely lost her vision and one year after she met the true power of God when she converted. Even though, she had visual disability, she tried to work in family homes and even in a



company. With great persistence she started approaching the work of God, where truly she was supposed to be. God started speaking with her about missionary work outside of Brasilia, but she thought that would be impossible because she had her limitations. She first went to the city of Santos, in the State of São Paulo, Brazil, where she experienced the mysteries and secrets of God. She stayed there for four years. After her stay, God had prepared the Missionary Ivanir Lima to follow her out of São Paulo, until then she did not know where the Lord would take her.

After some time it was revealed to her that would be the State of Santa Catarina, to the south of Brazil. They had plenty to do: in the hospital, and in evangelism of door to door. They made a difference in the kingdom of God. The local pastor, Alvarino and the "Mission" Ministry brought them to four different places where they could actually develop the mission. They went places, distant, difficult and arduous, but the Lord Jesus Christ always went in front of them to lead and deliver them with a strong hand. Today, these places are temples full of souls in the glory of God. The missionary Diacui returned to Brasilia thinking it was over and she would rest. She fooled herself: she was just beginning. But still she never thought that God could do what he did for her. She went through a very difficult time because her mother got very sick and the missionary Diacui was crushed and crushed over again by God, suffering and pain she experienced in the last days of her mother's life, but for the glory of Christ she was tested and approved, not by men or by women, but by God. Once again the missionary thought it was over, but again the Lord showed her that our lives do not belong to us. Through a simple phone call, the missionary met Pastor Maria de Lourdes Bonfim and she thought they would be just good friends, but the Lord once again surprised her with his miraculous deeds.

In August of 2010, she was consecrated as Missionary of "Way of Life Assembly of God" Church, in Planaltina/DF, Brazil. Today, the missionary Diacui rejoices in the miracles that the Lord has provided for her and sees how great the hand of God upon her is.
